

the the viewing of the proposed road in case the prayer of the petitioners shall not be granted it was ordered that C. E. Macy Abel Gates and Albert Stokes be appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor and that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the 23^d day of January ad 1870 at the house of H. W. Thompson and thence proceed to view and locate said proposed road.

A petition was presented and read signed by Patrick Callan and others asking that a road be located and established on the following route to wit: Begin at the N.E. corner of Section 9 Town 15 Range 19 thence South on Section line as near as practicable to the South line of Douglas County and the Board being satisfied that legal notice and publication had been made and Patrick Callan one of the petitioners having filed a bond with approved security conditioned for the payment of all costs of view in case the road shall not be established, it was ordered that C. H. Vanhook Henry Wibber and Thomas Hall be appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor and it was further ordered that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the 20^d day of March ad 1869 at the house of John Shepherd and thence proceed to view locate and survey said proposed road.

A petition was presented and read signed by William Barnicklow and others asking that a change be made in the State road leading from Olathe to Council Grove as follows starting at a point 24 rods north of the S.E. corner of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 33 Town 14 range 20 thence running N.W. to a point 18 rods East of the N.W. corner of the said N.E. 1/4 where the same intersects the present travelled road and the board being satisfied that legal notice and publication had been made and William Barnicklow one of the petitioners having filed his bond with approved security conditioned for the payment of all costs of view in case the prayer of the petitioners shall not be granted it was thereupon ordered that William B. Hayden Samuel Black and N. C. Coradit be appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor and that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the 3^d day of March ad 1869 at the house of William Barnicklow and thence proceed to view and survey said proposed road, as required by law.

A petition was presented and read signed by Joel Groves and others asking that a road be established at the following points to wit: Beginning at the N.W. corner of Section 11 Township 13 range 19 East of the 6th principal meridian thence due South to the S.W. corner of said Section so as to connect the Lawrence and Bloomington and the Lawrence and Marion roads and the Board being satisfied that legal notice and publication had been made of the petition it was on motion ordered that H. W. Goss G. D. Goads and Charles Longfellow be appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor and that said viewers and Surveyor meet at the house of Joel Groves on the 9^d day of February ad 1869 or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and thence proceed to view, locate and survey said proposed road.
