A petition was presented and read signed by Daniel Ducks and others asking that a road be established at the following points to wit: Beginning at a point on the Lawrence and Emporia road where said road crosses the Section line dividing Sections 31 and 32. Township 13 range 19 and running thence West on half section lines as near as practicable to the East side of a timbered ravine that runs northerly across the North West quarter of section 36 Township 13, range 19 thence Northerly along the east side of said ravine to a point near the Mason Cellar so called, thence on the most practicable route Westerly to the West line of Douglas County. The Board being satisfied that legal notice and publication had been made it was then upon Ordered that E. Disbrow Andrew Baldwin and Michael Albion be appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor. and that said viewers and Surveyors meet at the house of Daniel Ducks on the 9th day of March or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and thence proceed to view and survey said road as required by law.

A petition was presented and read signed by Joseph Lovelace and others asking that a part of the Lawrence and Marion be vacated as follows to wit: Vacate one rod in width off the North side of said road beginning at the S.E. Corner of Section 30 Town 13 range 19 and running thence West one half mile and the board being satisfied that legal notice and publication had been made it was ordered that Michael Albion G. W. Umbarger and Robt. Stiles be appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor and that said viewers and Surveyor meet at the house of E. J. Macey on the 23rd day of February AD 1869 or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and thence proceed to view locate and survey said proposed road.

The report of the viewers appointed on the petitions of W. H. H. Whitney and others having been filed in the Clerk's office as required by law - it was presented and read and being favorable to the establishment of the road and no legal objections being made thereto it was on motion Ordered that the report, plat and survey be recorded and that the Clerk issue the Order of the Board to the proper Owners of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel.
