

presented to the Board signed by Hiram Town and others asking that a change be made in the Lawrence and Leecompton middle road as follows to wit: That so much of said road as lies between the S.W. corner of Section 23 Township 12 Range 19 and the N.W. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 22 Township 12 Range 19 be vacated and the road changed so that it may run on section line commencing at the S.W. corner of Sec. 23 Town 12 Range 19 thence west to the intersection with a Township road established by the Board of Commissioners July 8 1864 and the commissioners being satisfied that legal notice and publication had been made it was Ordered by the Board that Alonzo Fuller Geo. Wells and John H. Wilder be appointed viewers of said proposed change and Holland Wheeler Surveyor and that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the day of ad 1869 at the house of Reuben Randall and thence proceed to view locate and survey said proposed change as required by law.

A petition was presented and read signed by E. D. Hughson and others asking that a part of the Leecompton middle road (so called) be vacated as follows to wit: that so much as lies along the East and North sides of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 21 Town 12 Range 19 and only so much as lies between what is known as the Sedgewick and the Charles Taylor roads and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve households of Douglas County and that notice and publication had been made according to law of the presentation of said petition and E. D. Hughson one of the petitioners having filed his bond with security conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved it is hereby Ordered that Alonzo Fuller Geo. Wells and John H. Wilder be and are hereby appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said proposed vacation of road and that they meet at the house of Reuben Randall on the 25th day of February and thence proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary Order to said viewers and Surveyor.

On motion the Board adjourned until Thursday the 4th Inst.
