

Lawrence Kansas April 5 1869

The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to law. There were present Commissioners Gutter, Griffith and Platts and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

The following proceedings were had

A petition was presented signed by Anton Guffler and others asking that a licence be granted to George King to keep a ferry at Eudora.

On motion it was ordered that a licence be granted to Geo King to keep a ferry at Eudora for one year from the first day of April 1869 and it was further ordered that the clerk issue in the name of the Board a licence to said Geo King upon his producing a receipt from the County Treasurer for \$15. licence tax. It was further ordered that the rates of ferryage be established as last fixed by the Board.

In pursuance of an act of the legislature of the State of Kansas approved February 26 1869 concerning common schools it is hereby ordered that Mrs Mary E Carpenter of Lawrence and Pleasant Heatt of Eudora be and are hereby appointed members of the County Board of Examiners.

The annual reports of the Trustees of Eudora, Marion, Clinton and Drexelton were presented examined and approved.

The account of G. C. Hall for \$8.97 and John Young for \$103.80 for illegal tax paid were presented examined and allowed.

On motion the Board adjourned until Wednesday April 7 1869
