

having been read at the meeting of the Board April 5 1869 and laid over temporarily it was again publicly read and being favorable to the establishment of the change and no legal objections being made the Board being of opinion that said change of road as viewed and surveyed will be of public utility it is ordered that the report survey and plat be recorded and that said road be established as changed. it is further ordered that the County Clerk issue an order in the name of the Board to the proper Overseer of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of the road the report of the viewers was this day publicly read and said viewers having filed a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages that they have assessed to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their premises. Said report was also read and the Board being of opinion that the compensation awarded by said viewers to the several claimants to wit: E. Huddleston \$75. Compensation. To Wilder Knight \$75. Compensation is reasonable and just except that the amount awarded to Wilder Knight should be but \$50. and which amounts off \$15 to E. Huddleston and \$50. to Wilder Knight is hereby allowed and the County Clerk is hereby authorized to draw his order upon the County Treasurer in favor of said claimants for the amounts allowed and it is ordered that the reports, survey and plat be recorded and said road established sixty feet in width and it is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary order to the proper Overseer of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel as required by law.
