The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows. Beginning at the South West corner of Section 16 Township 12 Range 20 thence South as near as practicable one mile, and William Stine one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of the costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of Douglas County, and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given according to law, it is Ordered that A. G. Norman, C. Darling and A. G. Brooks, three disinterested householders of the County, be and they hereby are, appointed Viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor, of said road, and that they meet at the house of A. G. Norman on the 24th day of May, ¹⁸⁶⁹ at ten o'clock A.M. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary order to the said Viewers and Surveyor and that said Viewers and Surveyor report their proceedings in the premises to this Board at its next session.

In the matter of the petition
of James F. Cameron and
others for a county road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows. Beginning at the S.E. corner of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 13 Town 12 Range 19 thence West as near as practicable, One half mile, to the S.W. corner of said quarter section thence North one quarter of a mile, and James F. Cameron one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least 12 householders of Douglas County, and that notice of the presentation has been given as required by law it is Ordered that A. G. Brooks, C. Darling and Wm. Stine be and they hereby are, appointed Viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that they meet at the Fall house in North Lawrence on the 24th day of May 1869 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further Ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary order to said Viewers and Surveyor.
