

In the matter of the
Petition of G. W. Pickens and
others for a country road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows, begin at a point on the section line dividing Sections 11 and 12 Town 12 Range 17 where the Lawrence and Topeka road crosses said section line thence North on section lines as near as practicable to the Kansas river. and G. W. Pickens one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least 12 householders and that notice of the presentation has been given according to law, it is ordered that R. W. Drummer, Thomas H. Clarke and James Beach be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that they meet at the house of G. W. Pickens on the 11th day of June and after being duly sworn proceed to discharge the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to said viewers and Surveyor and that said viewers and Surveyor report their proceedings in the premises to the Board at its next session.

Petition of E. C. Macy
and others for a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows, beginning at the S.E. corner of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 36 Township 13 Range 18 thence North and North Westerly to the Steel Ford on Rock Creek thence Northward to Kansas Avenue in the town of Bloomington at the point known as Henry Stokes corner thence West along said Avenue to the Section line thence North on said line to the Lawrence and Emporia State road, and E. C. Macy one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least 12 householders of Douglas County and that notice of the presentation has been given according to law, it is ordered that Abel Yates, E. W. Godwin and Lyman Heickot be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that they meet on the 8th day of June 1869 at the house of E. C. Macy and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to the said viewers and Surveyor and that said viewers and Surveyor report their proceedings in the premises to this Board at its next session.
