

In the matter of the petition
of P. A. Dolbee and others
for a County road

The petitioners having made application
for the establishment of a road as follows.

Beginning at the South East corner of the South East quarter of Section 17 Township
13 Range 19 thence North on line between Sections 16 and 17, 8 and 9 to a point on said
line opposite the house of B. Gentry thence by the most practicable route to a point
on the line dividing the North East and South East quarters of Section 8 Township
range 19 where a road leading from the Leavenworth middle road to the
Kansas river angles North, and P. A. Dolbee one of the petitioners having entered
into an obligation payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas
conditions for the payment of all costs and expenses according to said
application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, and it ap-
pearing that said petition is signed by at least 12 householders of Douglas
County and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according
to law It is ordered that William Barker, Ebenezer Baldwin and Charles
Taylor be and they hereby are appointed Surveyors and Commissioners
of said road and that said Surveyors and Commissioners meet at the house of P. A.
Dolbee on the 28th day of June 1869 and after being duly sworn proceed to
the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law.
It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board
the necessary orders to said Surveyors and Commissioners as that said Surveyors report
their proceedings in the premises to this Board at its next session.

In the matter of the Application
of Ransoms and Howard
to purchase tax title of Lots
in the town of Clinton

The petitioners having made appli-
cation to purchase the certificates of sale
and all claim of the County for taxes on certain lots in the town of Clinton

It is ordered that the Treasurer and County Clerk be authorized to assign
all certificates of sale for taxes and all interest of the County on account of unpaid
taxes on any lot in the town of Clinton to J. H. Ransom and J. H. Howard
upon the payment of the County Treasurer of seventy five cents for each lot
provided that all certificates or interest of the County in any block shall
be taken and that all expenses of assignments and dunning shall be paid
by the said Howard and Ransom.

In the matter of the failure
of the Township Clerk of
Palmyra Township to
file oath and Bond

The Township Clerk elect of Palmyra
Township having failed to file oath and
bond as required by law thereby occasioning a vacancy in said office
It is ordered that J. T. Starr be and he hereby is appointed Township Clerk
in and for Palmyra Township to fill vacancy occasioned by the fail-
ure of the Township Clerk elect to qualify. A petition was presented
signed by John Egan and others asking the Board to take the necessary steps
to secure a free bridge over the Kansas River at Lawrence, Ordered
that the petition be laid over for the present.
