County all certificates of sale and interest of the County acquired
by reason of sales for taxes on certain lots in the town of Leocompton
for which he offers to pay twenty-five cents per lot for such certificates
and interest. It is ordered that the County Treasurer and clerk
be authorized to assign all certificates held by the County and all its
interest of the County acquired by reason of sales for taxes on all lots in
Blocks 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44 and forty five 45
except lots 1, 2 and 3 in Block 20, ^{in the town of Leocompton} upon the payment by said D. J. Mitchell
to the Treasurer of the sum of twenty-five cents per lot for each lot so trans-
ferred the said Mitchell to pay all costs of assignments.

On motion it was ordered that the County Attorney be requested to
confer with John Shew in relation to the lease held by the County
on his building on Massachusetts Street in Lawrence and if possible have
