The Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, met pursuant to
adjournment. There were present Commissioners Cutler, Griffith
and Platts and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

The viewers having reported in favor of the
establishment of the road the report was
this day publicly read and no legal objections being made, and the Board
being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of
public utility, it is ordered that the report of the viewers with the sur-
vey and plat of said road be recorded and that said road be
established a public highway. It is further ordered that the County
Clerk issue in the name of the Board an order to the proper over-
seers of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel
as required by law.
