

In the matter of the petition
of William B Barker
and others for a county road

The views having reported in favor of the establishing of said road the report was this day publicly read and no objections being made and the Board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility, it is ordered that the reports of said views with the survey and plat of said road, be recorded, and that said road be established a public highway. And said views having filed a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages which they have assessed to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises said report was also read. And the Board being of opinion that the damages awarded by said views to the several claimants to wit: To Leonard R. Bryan \$300. Damages To Wm M. Hare \$100. damages and to H. Langston \$25. damages is reasonable and just except the amount allowed to H. Langston that said road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said damages out of the County Treasury it is ordered that the County Clerk draw his order upon the County Treasurer in favor of L. R. Bryan. and Wm M. Hare for the amount of damages so awarded them respectively. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board an order to the proper Overseer of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law.

A communication was presented signed by Robert Morrow setting forth that Lot No 78 Vermont Street, Lawrence is owned by Mrs Stewart a widow in destitute circumstances and that in consequence of poverty she had been unable to pay taxes on said lot for several years and that the lot had been sold for taxes, and that she is utterly unable to redeem the same and asking that the Interest on the sales for taxes be abated. On motion it was ordered that the County Treasurer be authorized to allow Mrs Stewart to redeem said lot from the sales for taxes upon payment of the amount originally paid for without interest.

The views having reported in favor of the establishment of said road, said report was this day publicly read and said views having filed a separate report in writing in relation to damages claimed which report was also read - and the Board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility, it is ordered that the reports of said views with the survey and plat of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue an order in the name of the Board directing the proper Overseer of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel according to law. The Board adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.
