Ordered That the sum of Seventy five Dollars be and the same hereby is appropriated for temporary support of Poor in Palmyra Township for the year commencing May 1st 1869 and that the County Clerk issue an Order on the County Treasurer payable to the Overseer of Poor in said Township for said amount.

The Board adjourned until Tomorrow morning at Nine O'clock

In the matter of the Petition of August Wulfschla and others for a county road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road this report was this day publicly read and after hearing arguments for and against the establishment of the said road It is Ordered by the Board that the further consideration of the report be postponed for the present.

In the matter of the Petition of Geo. W. Reynolds and others for a county road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the South East corner of Section 22 Town 13 Range 13 thence East as near as practicable on the Section line, One mile, to the intersection of a North and South road. and G. W. Reynolds one of the petitioners having filed his bond payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas in the sum of One hundred Dollars conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is hereby accepted and approved, and it appearing that not less than twelve House holders of Douglas County, have signed said petition and that notice of the presentation has been given according to law It is hereby ordered that William Leitchfield E. P. Briggs and F. F. Bruner be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Charles Surveyor of said road
