

of Shelton Sturges and others reference is hereby made, by the terms of which said contract, and the accompanying bond of Shelton Sturges and others the bonds of said County of Douglas to be issued in subscription for stock in said road company to be placed on special deposit in the Bank of New York National Banking Association to be delivered to said railroad company as in said contract and bond stated, and whereas at a meeting of the Board of Directors of the Lawrence and Galveston Railroad Company held in the city of Chicago Illinois on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June ad 1869 a resolution of said company was passed requesting that the said bonds of Douglas County should be sent to and deposited with the President of said Railroad Company instead of being deposited with the Bank of New York as stipulated in the aforesaid Contract and Bond. <sup>W</sup> Hufmon resolved that the Chairman of the Board be authorized and instructed to deposit with the President of the said Lawrence and Galveston Railroad Company, the sum hundred One thousand dollar Bonds of the County of Douglas heretofore prepared in accordance with the said resolution of November 6<sup>th</sup> 1868 in pursuance of the vote of the people of said County authorizing a subscription to the capital stock of said Railroad to be delivered to said Railroad Company, in accordance with the terms and conditions of said Contract and Bond as herein modified. Resolved that for the purpose of enabling said rail road company to pay the taxes due the County of Douglas upon the property of said company and the local debts of said company as contemplated by resolution of said Company passed June 30 1869 the Chairman of the County Board is hereby authorized and instructed to detach from said bonds the matured interest coupons theron and deliver the same to the Superintendent of said Rail road company and the County Treasurer is hereby authorized and instructed to pay the amounts due upon said coupons upon presentation. On motion it was ordered that the resolutions be adopted.

Ordered that the Board stand adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock
