

May to the first day of February in each year and it appearing that a majority of the qualified Electors of said Townships have signed said petition it is ordered that all persons owning cattle and horses in the Township of Marion shall keep the same confined in the night time from the first day of May until the first day of February in each year. it is further ordered that the County Clerk cause the foregoing order to be published according to law.

A petition was presented signed by W. H. Abrams and others asking the Board to appropriate money to build a bridge over Muddy Creek between Sections 7 and 8 Town 13. Range 20 E. On motion. Ordered that that A. S. Norman Trustee of Grant Township do and he hereby is appointed a Commissioner to make an estimate of the cost of building a bridge at the point named in the petition according to such plan as he may deem best and report the same to this Board.

A petition was presented signed by W. H. Gill and others asking the Board to cause to be erected a bridge over Toynis branch so called in Palmyra Township, also a bridge over Coal Creek one fourth of a mile East of Frank's Farm in said Palmyra Township. On motion Ordered that David Kerns Trustee of Palmyra Township do and he hereby is appointed a Commissioner to make accurate estimates of the cost of building bridges at the points named in the petition in accordance with such plans as he may deem best and report the same to the Board.

A petition was presented signed by A. J. Jennings and several others asking the Board to build a bridge over Little Wakarusa Creek on the line of a road commencing at the Eudora and Black Jack road and running West on Township line. On motion Ordered that A. D. H. Kempfer Trustee of Eudora Township do and he hereby is appointed a Commissioner to procure estimates of the cost of a bridge at the point named in the petition and report the same to the Board.
