The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read. F. A. Dr Wolf objected to the establishment of the road on the grounds that the viewers were not disinterested householders of the County of Douglas and that the proceedings of the board under said petition were not in accordance with law. The objections were overruled. The viewers having filed a separate report in writing of the amount of compensation and damages awarded by them said report was also read. And the Board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility it is ordered that the viewers report with the survey and plat of said road be recorded and that said road be established. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary order to the owners of roads through which said road is located to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

The viewers having reported against the establishment of the change It is ordered that the case be dismissed without further proceedings and that the costs be paid by the petitioners.
