

South half of the South East quarter of section 11, thence west by the most practicable route to the North bank of the Wakarusa creek at the east boundary of the South West quarter of section 12 all of the same township and range, thence beginning at the South West corner of the North East quarter of section 13 town 13 range 20, thence east to a north and south road: And W. H. Saunders one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is hereby accepted and approved. And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of Douglas county and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law. it is ordered that G. W. Smith Jr. O. A. Hausman and D. J. Watt be appointed viewers and Holland ^{Whelan} Surveyor of said road and that said viewers and Surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 25th day of August 1889 (or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter) and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments as required by law. it is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and Surveyor.

In the Matter of the petition
of John B. Stump and
others for a county road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows, begun at the North West corner of the South West quarter of section 34 Township 14 range 19, thence South on section line, as near as practicable, one mile. thence east on half section line as near as practicable to intersect the Lawrence and Fort Scott road. And John B. Stump one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the state of Kansas, for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted. and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition had been given according to law. it is ordered that David Kerns, William Barnicklow and Samuel Carman be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Whelan Surveyor of said road and that said viewers and Surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 17th day of August ad 1889 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. it is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to the said viewers and Surveyor.
