The petitioners having made application for the alteration of a road as follows that the road known as the Secoypton and Sac Agency road be changed, commencing at the stake north of the south east corner of the south west quarter of section 34 town 13 range 18 where the road angles north west, and run north on said line about eighty rods, to the corner of the fence, then angle north west along said fence to intersect said road about thirty rods at the end of the stone wall, and T. E. Sawyer one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred Dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law, it is ordered that Jesse McKinney, James C. Stule and J. W. Bullcock be and they hereby are appointed Reivers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that said Reivers and Surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in the petition on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September 1869 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, as required by law.
