others for the alteration of a road.

The petitioners having made application for the alteration of the road commencing at the south west corner of section 1 town 13 range 18 and running west to the West line of Douglas County, as follows begin at a point in the section line between sections 4 and 9 town 13 range 18 where said road leaves the section line and angles north West, thence along said road to where it again intersects the section line. That the portion of road described be changed and located on the section line and H. A. Cummings one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars, payable to the state of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of Douglas County and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law it is ordered that D. D. Keill William Lewis and Henry Howard be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler surveyor of said road, and that said viewers and surveyors meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition, on the seventh day of September 1869, and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition  
of John Doak and others  
for a county road.

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows, beginning at the present south terminus of a road dividing sections 4 and 5 and 8 and 9 of township 10 range 20 and to continue to the south line of the county, and John Doak one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred Dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders
