The petitioners having made application for alteration of roads as follows, asking that the following described roads be vacated, beginning at a point on the road running north and south between sections 9 and 10 township 14 range 20 near where the Leavenworth Lawrence and Galveston Rail road crosses said road and vacate all of said road lying East of the rail road, also to vacate the road commencing near the south east corner of the south west quarter of section 10 township 14 range 20 running thence north westerly to the north west corner of the north east quarter of section 9 said township and range. And that a road be established beginning at a point where the Leavenworth Lawrence, and Galveston rail road crosses the section line between sections 9 and 10 and running thence as near as practicable along the west side of said rail road to intersect the road running east and west across the north east quarter of said section 9, also that a road be located and established beginning at the north east corner of the south east quarter of the north west quarter of section 10 township 14 range 20 thence due west as near as practicable to the west side of the rail road. And W. E. Barnes one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said applications in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas, and that legal notice of the presentation of the petition has been given, it is ordered that Samuel Carman, Stephen Ogden and J. S. Starr be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that said viewers and Surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 31st day of August A.D. 1869 or failing to meet on said day within five days thereafter and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law.
