

Monday July 26 1869

The board of commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment. There were present commissioners Geo. Suttles, G. W. Griffith and Aaron E. Platts, and Paul R. Brooks county clerk.

Mr. H. Beach county treasurer presented his report of receipts and disbursements from July 12 1868 to July 12 1869 with vouchers. The report and vouchers were examined and on motion the report was accepted and adopted.

Ordered that the county clerk be and he hereby is instructed to prepare a statement of the receipts and expenditures of the county from July 12 1868 to July 12 1869 also a statement of the financial condition of the county on the 12th day of July 1869.

In the matter of the petition of August Wulfkuhle and others for county roads

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of the roads prayed for and said report having been publicly read on the 9th day of July 1869 and the case postponed temporarily, it was this day again publicly read and no legal objections being made the board being satisfied that said roads as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility it is ordered that the viewers report with the survey and plat of said roads be recorded and that said roads be established. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper owners of roads directing him or them to cause said roads to be opened for public travel.

The claims for damages of H. A. Wittich and J. D. Faxon were allowed as recommended by the viewers to wit H. A. Wittich \$20. J. D. Faxon \$30.
