The Board of Commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment. There were present commissioners Luther Griffith, and Platts, and Paul R. Brooks county clerk.

The board proceeded to estimate and determine the amount of money to be raised by tax for county purposes with the following result.

For Judicial Expenses	\$7000.
" Jail	4000.
" Support of poor	5000.
" Election Expenses	500.
" Roads and road damages	2000.
" Fuel and Stationery	1700.
" Pay of County Officers	7000.
" Printing and Advertising	1000.
" Incidental expenses	3000. 312.
" Interest on bonds	29.750.

On motion ordered that a tax be levied on all the taxable property of the county for current expenses, of one half of one per cent and that a tax of one half of one per cent be levied on all taxable property for the purpose of paying interest on outstanding bonds. It is further ordered that a tax of three mills on the dollar be levied on all taxable property in the county except in incorporated cities for road purposes.
