

In the matter of the petition
of Peter Bohner and others for
the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road and no legal objections being made nor damages claimed the board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility, it is ordered that the viewers report with the survey and plat of said road be recorded and that said road be established. It is further ordered, that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper owners of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

In the matter of the petition
of William Christian and
others for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of the road said report was this day publicly read and no legal objections being made. The board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility, it is ordered that the report of the viewers with the survey and plat be recorded and that said road be established. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper owners of roads, to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

alteration of a road

G. Mankle appeared and asked permission to withdraw the petition whereupon it is ordered that leave be granted to withdraw the petition upon payment of all costs accrued upon said petition.

In the matter of the petition
of G. H. Reynolds and others
for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported against the establishment of said road the report was read and it is ordered that said petition be dismissed without further proceedings and that the petitioners pay the costs and expenses that have been caused by their aforesaid application.

In the matter of the petition of
D. G. Kennedy and others for
the establishment of a county road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows. Beginning at the South West corner of Section 7 Town 14 range 21 running south on section line or as near as practicable to the South West corner of the North West quarter of Section 31. Thence East on the half section line to the North East corner of the South West quarter of said Section 31. Thence South on the half section line to where the Santa Fe road strikes the West line of the Black Jack town site. And D. G. Kennedy one of the petitioners having filed his bond
