It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board, the necessary order to said viewers and Surveyor.

And A. J. Smith one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law, it is ordered that Thomas H. Kennedy, Asa Dutton and Pettit be, and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Whelan Surveyor of said road and alteration, and that they meet at the house of Wm. Edgerton on the 11th day of November 1869 or failing to meet on that day within five days thereafter and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their respective offices, according to law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue, in the name of the board the necessary order to the said viewers and Surveyor.
