

report was this day publicly read, and said viewers having filed a separate report in writing, of the amount of compensation and damages which they have assessed to land owners by reason of the location of said road through their several premises said report was also publicly read, and the board being of opinion that the compensation and damages awarded by said viewers to wit: to R. L. Williams eighty dollars damages is reasonable and just and that said road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said damages out of the county treasury, and no legal objections being made, it is ordered that the county clerk draw an order upon the County Treasurer in favor of said R. L. Williams for the amount of damages so awarded, that the several reports of the viewers, with the plat and survey of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway, it is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper owners of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

In the matter of the petition of
John B. Stump and others
for the establishment of a road

The viewers having filed their report in the clerk's office recommending that the road be established and no legal objections being made thereto it was ordered that the road be established in accordance with the report, and that the clerk issue the order of the board to the proper owners of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel, and that the report, plat and survey be recorded as required by law.

Claims for damages allowed as recommended by viewers
to wit: B. G. Buckett claim of \$250. allowed at \$75. William Mitchell claim of \$250. allowed at \$75. R. Preston claim of \$200. not allowed.

In the matter of the petition
of J. H. Harrison and others
for alteration of a county road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of the change of road the report was this day publicly read and no legal objections being made, the board being of opinion that said change of road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility, it is ordered that the report of the viewers with the survey and plat of said change of road be recorded and that said alteration of road be established, it is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper owners of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

The claim of Herman Towne for damages was considered and rejected.
