

from the point of beginning (as laid out and surveyed) to the quarter section corner between sections thirty three (33) and thirty four (34) town twelve (12) range eighteen (18) will be useful to the public it is ordered that the aforesaid useful part of said road be established a public highway and that the report of said survey with the plat and survey be recorded, according to law. it is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board an order to the proper owners of roads directing them to cause said road to be opened for public travel.

In the matter of the appeal

Said James Crowder having appealed from the decision of the County Superintendent of Public Instruction, detaching the South East quarter of section eight (8) town (12) twelve Range nineteen (19) from district Number twenty (20) and attaching the same to school district No 69 the board (having conferred with the County Superintendent and heard the several parties) being of opinion that the decision of the Superintendent is a just and beneficial decision it is ordered that said decision be affirmed by this board.

In the matter of the petition of
Joseph Chamberlain for the
vacation of a part of the town
site of Palmyra in Douglas County.

The first Monday in October having been fixed as the day on which the board would hear evidence relating to the occupancy of the lands sought to be vacated and no parties appearing to protest against the said vacation it is ordered that the County Clerk make in the name of the board the necessary certificate as required by law certifying that that the provisions of section 23 of an act relating to town sites is duly applied to the part of said town site petitioned to be vacated and that said certificate and the plat accompanying said petition be filed in the office of the register of deeds of the County of Douglas.

Ordered that the Clerk advertise in the official paper of the County that bids will be received by the board until the 5th day of November 1869 for the purchase of tax certificates held by the County on all lots in the town of Big Springs.
