On motion of Mr. Griffith it is ordered that Wm. Meairs trustee of Wakarusa Township be and he hereby is appointed a commissioner to advertise for proposals for building a bridge across "Mud Creek" on the Leavenworth and Leavenworth road.

Ell. Pickens presented a written proposition to the board to purchase all the certificates of sale and all claim of the county on account of tax sales on all lots in the town of Big Springs. Whereupon it is ordered that the County Treasurer and county clerk be and they hereby are authorized and instructed to assign all certificates of tax sales on all lots in the town of Big Springs held by the county, or which have been sold to the county for taxes, upon the payment into the County Treasury of the sum of two hundred dollars, all costs of assignment to be paid by said Pickens.
