The board of county commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to law. Those were present Commissioners Geo. Cutler, W. McKiffith and Aaron E. Platts, and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

The following proceedings were had

A certified copy of the report of the Judge of the District Court and county attorney on the condition of the county jail, made at the November term of the District Court was presented and read. On motion ordered that the Sheriff be and he hereby is instructed to cause all insane persons committed to the jail from the county of Douglas County to be taken to the State Insane Asylum, at the earliest practicable time.

In the matter of the petition of A. J. Smith and others for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of the road the report was this day publicly read and no legal objections being made the board being of opinion that said road as laid out surveyed will be of public utility, it is ordered that the report of said viewers with the survey and plat of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered that the County Clerk in the name of the board an order to the proper officers of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel, as required by law.

L. J. Beam presented a written application asking to purchase the certificates of sale for taxes on certain lots in the town of Clinton at a price less than the amount of the sale and interest and offering to pay at the rate of seventy five cents per lot for all certificates of sale now held by the county, on motion it was ordered that the Com. Messrs. be and they are hereby authorized and directed to assign to L. J. Beam all certificates of sale held by the county, or to which the county is entitled on all lots in Blocks 42, 49, 50, 51, 52, 70, 71, 84, 96 and 97 in the town of Clinton upon the payment by said Beam of the sum of seventy five cents for each lot on which the county holds any certificate
