

In the matter of the petition

The petitioners having made applica-
tion for the vacation of a road located
diagonally across the South West quarter of Section ten (10) Town fourteen
(14) range twenty (20) and W.C. Barnes one of the petitioners having filed
his bond in the sum of One hundred Dollars payable to the State of Kansas
for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all
costs and expenses accruing on said application in case the prayer
of the petitioners is not granted which bond is accepted and approved
and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house-
holders of the County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation
of said petition has been given according to law it is ordered that E.P. Briggs
William Cutchfield and William Meairs be and they hereby are appointed
viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said vacation and that they
meet on the 20th day of January ad 1870 at the place of beginning desig-
nated in said petition and after being duly sworn proceed to the dis-
charge of the duties of their several appointments according to law.
It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the
Board the necessary order to the Viewers and Surveyor.

Wm M. Black and others for
the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made ap-
plication for the establishment
of a road as follows: beginning at or near a point where a town-
ship road crosses the section line running North and South divi-
ding sections thirty four (34) and thirty five (35) and twenty six (36) and
twenty seven (37) in township fourteen (14) range nineteen (19) thence run-
ning East along the section line dividing thirty five (35) and twenty six (36) and
thirty six (36) and twenty five (35) in township fourteen (14) range nineteen (19) and
sections thirty (30) and thirty one (31) and twenty nine (29) and thirty two (32) in
township fourteen (14) range twenty (20) to a township road running from
Prairie City to the Santa Fe road and dividing sections thirty two (32) and
thirty three (33) and twenty eight (38) and twenty nine (29) in township fourteen
(14) range twenty (20) a distance of about three and a half miles. And
Wm M. Black one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One
hundred and fifty dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the
County of Douglas. conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing
upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which
bond is accepted and approved. and it appearing that said petition is signed
by at least twelve house holders of the County of Douglas and that notice
of the presentation of said petition had been given according to law it is ordered
that Wm Baricklow L. M. Snyder be and they hereby are appointed
viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that they
meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 19th
day of January 1870 and after being duly sworn proceed to the
discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to
law, it is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name
of the Board the necessary order to the Viewers and Surveyor.
