

In the matter of the petition of
E. M. Bonner and others for the
establishment of a road and for
a change in a state road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road and for the alteration of a state road as follows, beginning at the North West corner of block nine (9) in the original town plat of Bloomington, thence West to the North West corner of block number eleven (11) in said town plat thence South to where the Lawrence and Emporia road is now located and cause that part of the Lawrence and Emporia road lying between the above named points to be vacated and null and void as a public road. Also: to establish a road to wit: beginning at the South West corner of block 14 in in the original town plat of Bloomington, thence North on the section line or as near as practicable to the South West corner of the North West quarter of section 13 town 13 range 18. And E. M. Bonner one of the petitioners having having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted. which bond is accepted and approved. and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law it is ordered that J. C. Steele, E. Dismar and Gabriel Marckle be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler surveyor of said road and that they meet on the 25th day of January ad 1870 at the place of beginning of said proposed road as designated in said petition and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. it is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyor.

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows beginning at a stake and stone by the Lawrence and Emporia state road near the school house in District number 26 near the quarter section line dividing the North East quarter of section number 32 town 13 range 18, owned by L. D. Bailey, from the North West quarter of said section, owned and occupied by Amos Jacobs thence running Southward on said dividing line between Bailey and Jacobs, as near as practicable, and on or near line dividing land of John Moss from land of Henry Stauffer and L. D. Bailey, to the South line of Clinton Township, thence on the best ground for road to meet road running past the dwelling house of Frederick Badsey. and John Moss one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of ~~Two~~^{One} hundred Dollars payable to the state of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application
