Beginning at the center of the road on the line running between nineteen (19) and twenty (20) thence up the bank of the river to the center line of section thirteen (13) township twelve (12) range nineteen (19) thence North to the center of the road running East and West on the North side of section thirteen (13) of the aforesaid township and range and Thomas Jones one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred Dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted and it appearing that not less than twelve householders of the County of Douglas have signed said petition and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given according to law, it is ordered that J. L. Burnett F. W. Sparr and W. S. R. Blackman be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that said viewers and Surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the 7th day of February 1870 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to said viewers and Surveyor.
