

the petitioner having filed his bond in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioner be not granted which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law it is ordered that J. M. Pivson, William Lewis and Moses Bigelow be, and they hereby are appointed viewers, and Holland Wheeler Surveyor, and that said viewers and Surveyor meet at the place of beginning designated in the petition and on the 9th day of February 1870 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. it is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board, the necessary order to the viewers and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of
J. C. Hough and others for the
establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows, beginning at or near the intersection of section lines between sections 26, 27, 34 and 35 Township 13 range 20 in said County thence East along said section line to its intersection with section line dividing sections 26, 27, 34 and 35 of Town 13 range 21 at the East line of said County a distance of six miles from the place of beginning, and J. C. Hough one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Five hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioner be not granted, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas and that legal notice of the presentation of the petition has been given, it is ordered that Wm. H. Gill John Fancett and Geo. Liggitt be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the 15th day of February 1870 at the place of beginning designated in said petition and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. it is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and Surveyor.
