Lawrence Kansas February 2 1870

The board of commissioners of the County of Douglas Kansas met pursuant to adjournment. Then were present Commissioners Groves, Jones and Hinshaw and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk. The following proceedings were had

Mr Hinshaw offered the following preamble and order. Whereas; it has come to the knowledge of this board, that many of the schools in the county have not been visited during the past year, by the County Superintendent of public instruction, and there being great complaints of the manner in which the office is conducted; and whereas the law, fixing the salaries of County Superintendents requires the person filling the office to devote his time exclusively to the duties of the office and whereas no penalty is prescribed in the said law, therefore be it resolved by this board that the members of the legislature from this county be requested to secure the passage of a bill through the legislature fixing a proper penalty for the failure of County Superintendents ^{to perform the duties} required of them by law.
