In the matter of the petition of
Frederick Haas and others for
the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows. beginning at the South East corner of Section Eleventh (17) township fifteen (15) range nineteen (19) running thence North as near as practicable on the section line to the North line of Section twenty eight (28) township fourteen (14) range nineteen (19) and Frederick Haas one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved. and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law. it is ordered that E. H. Vanhooker, Thomas M. Hoall and William Gilges be and they are hereby appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler surveyor of said road. and that said viewers and surveyor meet on the 31st day of May ad 1870 at the place of beginning designated in the petition and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. it is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyor.

of John E. Campbell and others
for the establishment of a road

The petitioner having made application for the establishment of a road as follows beginning on the County line between the counties of Douglas and Johnson at a point where the section line between sections fifteen (15) and twenty two (22) township thirteen (13) range twenty one (21) intersects said County line thence West on said section line or as near thereto as practicable until it intersects the range line. four (4) miles West of the County line or place of beginning. and John E. Campbell one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted. which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation has been given according to law. it is ordered that B. Thomas, J. Towneend and H. W. Carr be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler surveyor of said road and that said viewers and surveyor meet on the 31st day of May
