The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows beginning at a point twenty chains South and fifteen chains East of the North West corner of the South East quarter of Section Six (6) Township Thirtieth (30) range twenty (20) thence West 55°, chains 10 intersect with a road established by the board of Commissioners of the County of Douglas November 29 1869, and R. C. Parker one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One Hundred Dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application, in case the prayer of the petition be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law, It is ordered that H. L. Evans, E. W. Smith Jr and W. A. Watts be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the 25th day of May 1870 at the place of beginning designated in the petition and, after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law, it is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and Surveyor.

Joseph Fager and others for
the establishment of a road.

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows commencing at the North end of what is known as Barnicklow's street as laid down on the lithograph map of the Town of Palmyra thence running North on (or as near as practicable) the section line dividing Sections 27 & 28, 33 and 34 to the South East Corner of Section 27, thence East on the section line dividing Sections 22 and 27 to a point where said section line intersects the present travelled road from Baldwin City via the Villard Muddy of Mrs E. Barnes to Lawrence and Joseph Fager one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petition be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law, it is hereby ordered that Geo. W. Fitz, H. H. Williams and W. L. G. Soule be and they are hereby appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the tenth day of May 1870
