for the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows. Beginning at the South East corner of Section Ten (10) Township fourteen (14) range twenty one (21) thence West on section line as near as practicable to intersect a road running Southwesterly across Sections seven (7) and eighteen (18) Township fourteen (14) range twenty (20) or as much thereof as may be deemed practicable. and George Cutter one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred Dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law. it is ordered that C. M. Sears, Thomas Peavey and Thomas Rayson be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler surveyor of said road and that said viewers and surveyor meet on the 11th day of May 1870 at the place of beginning designated in the petition and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. it is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to the viewers and surveyor.

On motion Ordered that the County Treasurer be and he is hereby instructed to transfer the sum of five thousand dollars from the interest fund collected for the year 1869 to the general county fund.

In the matter of the petition
of J. C. Hough and others
for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and no legal objections being made, the board being of opinion, that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility, it is ordered that the report of said viewers be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered, that the County Clerk issue an order in the name of the board directing the proper officers of roads to cause said road to be opened for public travel
