A petition was presented and read signed by Clarkson Reynolds and fifty two others residents of Palmyra township Eudora and Wakarusa townships asking that a new township be set off and organized out of territory therein designated. On motion ordered that the petition be laid over until the July session of the board.

Aaron Brundage Overseer of Poor in Willow Springs township asked for an appropriation of \$27.⁰⁰ for temporary support of poor in said township which was on motion granted.

William Meairs Trustee of Wakarusa Township presented his report of the affairs of said township for the year ending April 6th 1870 which was examined compared with his vouchers and approved.
