

from the point where said Emporia road strikes the East line to the point where it leaves the South line of said South East quarter of said section two (2) and Henry Hiatt one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred Dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing in said petition, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of the County of Douglas, it is ordered that W. B. Distrow J. C. Stule and M. W. Payne be and they are hereby appointed viewers, and Holland Whelan Surveyor of said road, and that said Viewers and Surveyor meet on the fifteenth day of June 1870, at the place of beginning of said proposed road, designated in the petition, and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their respective appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to said Viewers and Surveyor.

Henry Chibber trustee of Marion Township W. B. Distrow Trustee of Clinton Township, A. C. Norman, trustee of Grant Township, Robert Young trustee of Decatur Township, J. L. Vincent trustee of Kawwaka Township presented reports of the affairs of their respective townships for the past year which respectively, examined and compared with the vouchers submitted and approved.

David Kerns trustee of Palmyra township presented his report of the affairs of said township for the past year but not being accompanied with proper vouchers was referred to the County Clerk to be compared with vouchers when they shall be presented.

A. D. H. Simpson trustee of Eudora Township and Aaron Brundage Trustee of Willow Springs township presented their annual reports of the affairs of their respective townships for the past year and not being accompanied by vouchers the reports were referred to the County Clerk with instructions to compare the same with vouchers and presented.

A certified copy of the report of the Judge of the District Court and County Attorney on the condition of the County jail made at the February term of the District Court was presented read and ordered to be placed on file.

On motion Ordered that William Meais Trustee of Wakarusa Township be and he hereby is appointed a Commissioner to contract for a bridge to be built over the ravine on the Lawrence and Eudora road near the residence of O. A. Hauscorne at a cost of not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars said bridge to be built on stone abutments.

On motion Ordered that the Treasurer and County Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to transfer and assign all certificates of sale for taxes held by the County on the following described real estate to wit: The North West fractional quarter of Section 29 Township 11 range 18 to R. W. Sumner upon payment of \$50 to include all sales made to the County on said land.

A petition was presented signed by Charles Pella and 49 others setting forth that they are free holders and qualified electors of Eudora township and asking the Board to submit to the qualified electors of said township the question of subscribing stock to the Santa Fe & Lawrence
