

and Denver rail road and raising the bonds of the township in payment thereof in accordance with an act of the Legislature of the State of Kansas approved February 25 1870.

On motion Ordered that a special election be held by the qualified voters of Eudora Township on the 14th day of May 1870 at the usual place of holding elections in said township to vote upon the following propositions viz:

Shall the township of Eudora subscribe the sum of fifteen thousand dollars to the Capital Stock of the Saint Louis, Lawrence and Denver Rail road company and issue the bonds of said township in payment thereof said bonds payable as follows Five thousand dollars in ten years from the date of issue Five thousand dollars in fifteen years from the date of issue and five thousand dollars in twenty years from the date of issue payable at the office of the Treasurer of the County of Douglas said bonds to bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum payable annually in gold at the office of the Treasurer of the County of Douglas. Provided that said bonds shall not be delivered to said Rail road company until said company shall have their road completed and in running order through the township of Eudora, nor until said company shall have given ample security that it will locate and maintain a freight and passenger depot in the City of Eudora and further provided that in case the bonds herein referred to shall be voted, the bonds heretofore voted by the City of Eudora shall not be delivered to said company.

Ballots to be printed or written "For the Bonds" or "Against the Bonds" It is further Ordered that the County Clerk cause the foregoing order to be published in the Kansas Tribune, and cause copies of said notice to be posted in at least three public places in Eudora township prior to the 14th day of April 1870.

On motion Ordered that a special Election be held in the several voting precincts of the county at the usual places of holding elections on the 14th day of May 1870 for the purpose of voting upon the following proposition to wit: Shall the County of Douglas appropriate from the Treasury of the County money not exceeding in amount one and a half mills on the dollar of all the taxable property in the County to be expended under the direction of the Douglas County Agricultural Society and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas for the purchase and improvement of a tract of land for the use of said Agricultural Society, for the purpose of holding fairs and for other purposes of said Society. Ballots to be printed or written "For the proposition to appropriate money for the purchase of fair grounds" or "Against the proposition to appropriate money for the purchase of fair grounds."

The election to be held and returns made as provided by law for general elections. It is further Ordered that the Clerk cause the foregoing order to be published in the Kansas Tribune.

The County Clerk presented County Warrants to the amount of \$341.54 that had remained unclaimed in his office for a period of three years. The board proceeded to cancel said orders a list of which was made and filed in the County Clerk's office.
