Lawrence Kansas April 20th 1870

The board of commissioners met pursuant to adjournment, there were present commissioners Brown, Jones and Hinchshaw, and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk. The following proceedings were had.

Ordered that the County Clerk be and he hereby is authorized and instructed to procure the printing of Three hundred copies of the road law of the State for distribution to the Commissions of the several road districts.

Ordered that the action of the board in rejecting the bill of C. W. Angle and others at the last meeting of the board be reconsidered.

Ordered that the bill of C. W. Angle Justice of the peace, and others for fees in the case of State vs John C. Glidden and others be referred to the County Attorney for his opinion as to the liability of the county to pay such bill.

Ordered that Pleasant Whitt and Dora Huddleston be and they are hereby appointed members of the board of examiners in and for the county of Douglas.

Ordered that the sum of seventy five dollars be appropriated out of the general fund for the temporary support of poor in Eudora Township and that Three hundred dollars be appropriated out of said fund for support of poor in Palmyra Township and that fifty dollars be appropriated out of said fund for the temporary support of poor in Grant Township. It is further ordered that the Clerk draw his orders on the Treasurer for the several amounts so appropriated payable to the Commissions of poor of the several townships.

The report of David Kerns Comissioner of Poor in Palmyra township from July 8 1869 to April first 1870 showing expenditures in excess of appropriations to the amount of \$245.29 was presented read and adopted.
