

Douglas January 10 1867. and that so much of said road, established on said 10<sup>th</sup> day of January be vacated, as may be located in Section thirty five (35) Town Twelve (12) Range Nineteen (19).

And M. S. Beach one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law. It is ordered that E. Briggs, G. W. Goss and L. J. Worden be and they are hereby appointed Viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that said Viewers and Surveyor meet on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of July 1870 at the place of beginning designated in said petition, and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to said Viewers and Surveyor.

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the South East corner of the North East quarter of Section thirty four (34) Township Twelve (12) Range Twenty one (21) Thence running West on the quarter section line dividing Section thirty four (34) to where said line intersects the line of the proposed Lawrence and Pleasant rail road, thence in a South Westerly direction along the line of said rail road and near the river bluff as near as practicable about two miles intersecting the road leading from Eudora to Leavenworth near the present Eudora ferry. And Jonathan Weaver one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is hereby accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law, it is ordered that W. J. Kennedy, L. J. Sherry and William Hughes be and they are hereby appointed Viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road, and that said Viewers and Surveyor meet on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of August 1870 at the place of beginning designated in the petition and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their respective appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to said Viewers and Surveyor.
