

In the matter of the petition of
John Gilmore and others for
the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows, beginning at a point eight (80) rods East of the South West corner of Section thirty three (33) Township twelve (12) range twenty (20) running thence, North, about one hundred rods, thence in a North Westwardly direction until it strikes the quarter section line running East and West thence West to the quarter section corner between Sections thirty one (31) and thirty two (32) of said township and range, and John Gilmore one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that John C. Campbell, Levi Woodward and G. L. Hoag be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Whelan Surveyor of said road and that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the 16th day of August A.D. 1870 at the place of beginning designated in said petition, and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments, according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to the viewers and Surveyor.

Joseph Seeler and others
for the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at a point in the Lawrence and Marion road at the North West corner of the North East quarter of Section thirty two (32) in Township thirteen (13) range nineteen (19) and running East one hundred and sixty rods thence South to the South East corner of the said Section thence East about four hundred (400) rods or to where the travelled road angles to the South East. Thence in a South Eastwardly direction on the old surveyed road as near as practicable to where it intersects the Lawrence and Fort Scott road, and Joseph Seeler one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law. It is
