S. Hardwick and others for
the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows. Beginning at a point on the West line of the City of Lawrence in the center of Henry Street thence West to a point thence (12) feet West of the East line of land now owned by A. Manton and S. Hardwick one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law. It is ordered that C. E. Brannard, E. D. Ladd and W. W. Rabcock be and they are hereby appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road, and that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the 25th day of July 1870 at the place of beginning designated in the petition and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and Surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of
F. A. Derby and others for
the alteration of a road

The petitioners having made application for a change in the location of the Deempton and Clinton road. Beginning in the center of said road on the North bank of the Wakarusa river, thence Eastward to the quarter section line running North and South in Section two (10) township thence (12) range eighteen (18) thence Northward on the West side of said line to the section line, thence Westward to Mr Derby's stone fence thence Northward on the East side of said fence one half mile, thence North Eastward as near as practicable to the quarter section line running North and South in Section three (3) in said township and range then to intersect with said road as now established and to vacate all that part of said road as now established lying between the two above named points, and F. A. Derby one of the petitioners, having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said
