change in the Lawrence and Paola road

The petitioners having made application for the alteration of the State road leading from Lawrence to Paola, as follows: Beginning at the corner to sections 22, 23, 26, and 27 Town 13 range 20, thence vacating all of said road running North Westwardly to where it intersects the line dividing the North East and North West quarters of section 22 township 13 range 20. And that said road be located as follows, commencing as above and running thence, West to the South West corner of the South East quarter of said section 22. Thence North on half section line to the point of intersection above referred to. And Jacob Baker one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred Dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing upon said application in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved. And it appearing that said petition is signed by least twelve house holders of the County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law. It is ordered that Fitch Reed, Oscar Burroughs, and W. B. Kennedy be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road, and that said viewers and surveyor meet on the 25th day of August ad 1870 at the place of beginning designated in said petition and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law, it is further ordered that the county clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and surveyor.
