

and Osage counties where said line crosses the Emporia road to Lawrence thence South in said county line as near as practicable to the South line of Marion township, and David Robinson one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One Hundred Dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law. It is ordered that J. C. Metken, Henry Webber and Thomas Banks be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler surveyor of said road and that said viewers and surveyor meet on the 6th day of September 1870 at the place of beginning designated in the petition and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary order to the viewers and surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of J. C. Vincent and others for the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows commencing at the North East Corner of the N.E. 1/4 of Section twenty one (21) Township twelve (12) range eighteen (18). Thence South on the half Section line one mile to the South West Corner of the South East quarter of Section twenty one (21) Township twelve (12) range eighteen (18) And J. C. Vincent, one of the petitioners, having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas, for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said application, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the county of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given according to law. It is ordered that G. W. Jim, F. B. Hill and D. Martin be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler surveyor, and that said viewers and surveyor meet on the 30th day of August 1870 at the place of beginning designated in said petition, and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and surveyor.
