

East on said section line to the East side of said sections. Thence East on the section line between sections 25 and 34 to Arkansas Street in the City of Lawrence, Kansas, or to some more convenient point for uniting with Whitkop Street in said City of Lawrence. And Levi Ferguson one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said petition, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of said petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that C. D. Ladd, O. E. Beaman and C. D. Babcock, be, and they hereby are appointed viewers, and Holland Wholes, Surveyor, and that viewers and Surveyor meet on the 27th day of July 1876 and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments as required by law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to said viewers and Surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of
C. G. Macy and others for the
establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read, and no legal objections being made thereto. It is ordered that the report of the viewers together with the plat and survey be recorded, and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered, that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to the proper Overseers of roads, to cause said road to be opened for public travel, according to law.

In the matter of the petition of
John Moes and others for
the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read, and no legal objections being made, the Board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility, it is ordered that the report of the viewers together with the plat and survey of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board an order to the proper Overseers of roads to cause the same to be opened for public travel.

In the matter of the petition
of John C. Campbell and others
for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read, and no legal objections being made the Board being of opinion that said road as laid out and surveyed will be of public utility, It is ordered that the report of the viewers, together with the survey and plat of said road be recorded.
