The following proceedings were had:

Mr. L. Beach county Treasurer presented his report of receipts and disbursements for the year ending July 12 1870. The board examined the report with the vouchers accompanying and on motion ordered that the report be accepted and adopted.

Ordered that the county clerk be and he hereby is instructed to prepare a statement of the receipts and expenditures of the county for the year ending July 12 1870 and also a statement of the financial condition of the county on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 1870 and cause the same to be published.

Ordered that the county clerk be and he hereby is instructed to prepare and publish a notice warning all persons against driving Texas cattle into or through the county contrary to law.

In the matter of the execution

The county treasurer having issued an execution for the collection of a tax assessed to L. N. Snyder on personal property the board being satisfied that said tax is illegal It is ordered that the Treasurer be authorized to recall said execution and that said tax be remitted.
