

September 5 1876

The board of county commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment. There were present Commissioners Green Jones and Henshaw and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

The following proceedings were had:

The board proceeded to estimate and determine the amount of money to be raised by tax for county purposes and for interest on outstanding bonds, for the ensuing year. The following are the estimates.

For Judicial Expenses	\$6000.
" Jail "	3500.
" Support of poor	5000.
" Election Expenses	500.
" Roads and road damages	2500.
" Fuel and Stationery	1600.
" Pay of County Officers	7500.
" Printing and advertising	1000.
" Refunding Indian land tax	4500.
" Incidental Expenses	3000.
Total for County purposes	\$35100.
For Interest on outstanding bonds	21000.
Total for all purposes	\$56100.

Ordered that there be and hereby is levied on the taxable property of the county a tax of five mills on the dollar for general county purposes and a tax of three mills on the dollar for paying interest on outstanding bonds. It is further ordered that a Road tax of three mills on the dollar be and hereby is levied on all the taxable property of the county except incorporated cities.

The committee appointed by the board to receive from the county treasurer county orders and school fund orders paid by him which he might wish to turn over to the board made the following report:

To the board of commissioners of Douglas County

Your committee ^{appointed} to receive from the county treasurer any county orders paid by him which he might wish to turn over to the board respectfully report that on the 12th day of July 1876 they received from the Treasurer County Orders the amount of thirty nine thousand, nine hundred and fifty four dollars and ninety six cents (\$39,954.96) with interest allowed on same to the amount of sixty dollars and two cents (60.02) which orders we have carefully compared with the original record of county orders issued and find the same correct. We have made a list of said orders which find herewith. The treasurer also turned over to your committee orders of the county superintendent on the school fund, paid by him to the amount of \$11,300. Your committee further report that having cancelled the county orders they destroyed the same by burning, all of which is respectfully submitted.
