The board of commissioners of the county of Douglas met pursuant to adjournment. Those were present commissioners Grover Jones and Hinchshaw and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

The following proceedings were had.

In the matter of the petition
of James H. Kelley and
others for a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows commencing at the North West corner of section 36 township 14 range 19 running thence West on Section line or as near as practicable to the North West corner of the North East quarter of Section 33 town 14 range 18 thence North 1/2 mile to the half section line, thence West on half section line or as near as practicable to the West line of Douglas county, and James H. Kelley one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred Dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the county of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said petition, in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted, which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of said county, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given according to law, it is ordered, that J. C. Stule, E. Dierbre and Abel Yates do, and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Whiles Surveyor of said road, and that said viewers and surveyor meet at the place designated as the place of beginning, in the petition on the twenty second day of November ad 1870, and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue, in the name of the board the necessary order to said viewers and surveyor.
