

In the matter of the petition of
C. C. Emery and others for a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows: Beginning at the South West corner of the South East quarter of Section 29 township 12 range 19, thence North one mile and eighty rods thence East eighty rods, thence North eighty rods to an East and West road. And Charles C. Emery one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One hundred dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas, conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said petition in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted. And it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve house holders of the County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that Thomas Pierson, Harvey Cooley and J. H. Farnham be, and they hereby are, appointed viewers, and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road, and that said viewers and Surveyor meet on the 15th day of November 1870, at the place of beginning designated in said petition, and after being duly sworn, proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the Clerk, Clerk issue in the name of the board the necessary orders to said viewers and Surveyors.

In the matter of the petition of C. Lotholz
and others for the establishment of a
Change in the State road from Lawrence
to Deto in Johnson County Kansas.

Said petitioners having made application for a change in the Lawrence and Deto State road, as follows: Beginning at the point where said road crosses the section line between Sections 4 and 5 town 13 Range 21 East, thence vacating all of said road running North Easterly through sections 3 and 4 town 13 Range 21 and Section 34 town 12 range 21, to where it intersects the section line between Sections 34 and 35 town and range last aforesaid and that said road be located as follows to wit: Beginning at the 81st post 80 rods North of the South East corner of Section 5 town 13 range 21, running thence East to section line between Sections three (3) and four (4) thence North on section line to the North East corner of said Section four (4) thence East on township line to Captains Creek thence down said creek to the point of intersection above referred to, and C. Lotholz one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of Two hundred dollars payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said petition in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of said County of Douglas and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that Charles Durr, John Wilmore and William J. Kennedy be and they hereby are appointed viewers and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that they meet at the place of beginning designated in said petition on the tenth day of November AD 1870 and after being
