It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to said viewers and Surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of James Bass and others for the establishment of a road

The petitioners having made application for the establishment of a road as follows Beginning at the South East corner of Eudora Township, thence running East on the Section line between Sections 9 and 10, 15 and 16, Town 13 Range 21 to intersect the road laid off on the county line between Douglas and Johnson Counties and James Bass one of the petitioners having filed his bond in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, payable to the State of Kansas for the use of the County of Douglas conditioned for the payment of all costs and expenses accruing on said petition in case the prayer of the petitioners be not granted which bond is accepted and approved, and it appearing that said petition is signed by at least twelve householders of the County of Douglas, and that notice of the presentation of the petition has been given as required by law. It is ordered that G. S. Hoag, Thos. Darling and James Neal three disinterested householders of said County be and they hereby are appointed viewers, and Holland Wheeler Surveyor of said road and that they meet at the South East corner of Eudora Township on the 9th day of November AD 1870 at ten o'clock AM. and after being duly sworn proceed to the discharge of the duties of their several appointments according to law. It is further ordered that the County Clerk issue in the name of the Board the necessary orders to said viewers and Surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of L. Hardwick and others for the establishment of a road

The viewers having reported in favor of the establishment of said road the report was this day publicly read and no damages having been claimed and no legal objections being made it is ordered that the report of said viewers with the survey and plat of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway fifty feet in width.
